PURSUANT TO SECTION 2705.031 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, YOU ARE HEREBY GIVEN NOTICE THAT:

- 1. FAILURE TO APPEAR PURSUANT TO THIS ORDER MAY RESULT IN THE ISSUANCE OF AN ORDER FOR YOUR ARREST, AND THE ISSUANCE OF AN ORDER FOR THE PAYMENT OF SUPPORT BY WITHHOLDING AN AMOUNT FROM YOUR PERSONAL EARNINGS, OR BY REDUCING OR WITHHOLDING AN AMOUNT FROM SOME OTHER ASSET OF YOURS.
- 2. You have the right to counsel. If you cannot afford an attorney or believe that you are indigent, then you must apply for a public defender or court-appointed counsel within **three (3) business days** after receipt of this summons.
- 3. If you have failed to make a good faith effort to retain counsel or to obtain a public defender, then the Court may refuse to grant you a

CONTINUANCE AT THE TIME OF THE HEARING FOR THE PURPOSE OF YOUR OBTAINING COUNSEL.

- 4. The Court may grant limited driving privileges under Section 4510.021 of the Ohio Revised Code, pursuant to a request made by you, if your driver's license was suspended based on a Notice issued pursuant to Section 3123.54 of the Ohio Revised Code by the Child Support Enforcement Agency, and if the request is accompanied by a recent noncertified copy of a driver's abstract from the Registrar of Motor Vehicles.
- 5. IF YOU ARE FOUND GUILTY OF CONTEMPT FOR FAILURE TO PAY CHILD SUPPORT, FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH OR INTERFERENCE WITH A VISITATION OR PARENTING TIME ORDER OR DECREE, OR ANY OTHER MATTER ALLEGED, THE COURT MAY ORDER THE FOLLOWING:
 - a. If this is your **first offense**, you may be sentenced to a definite term of imprisonment of not more than **thirty (30) days in Jail**; fined not more than **two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00)**; or, both.
 - b. If this is your **second offense**, you may be sentenced to a definite term of imprisonment of not more than **sixty (60) days in Jail**; fined not more than **five hundred dollars (\$500.00)**; or, both.
 - c. If this is your **third offense**, you may be sentenced to a definite term of imprisonment of not more than **ninety (90) days in Jail**; fined not more than **one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00)**; or, both.
